Dave's Diner is a family-owned and operated restaurant located in Sebringville, Ontario, just three minutes west of Stratford. Now celebrating 25 years in business, Dave's Diner continues to serve high-quality, homemade meals in a welcoming atmosphere.

The journey began after Dave, who spent his entire adult life working in the industry—including 12 years at Bentley's in the 80s and 90s and as an executive chef at the Quality Inn in Woodstock—decided it was time to venture out on his own. When an empty space became available in the old Sobey's plaza on Queens Land, Dave and his wife Nadine took the leap and opened their own diner. After 13 successful years there, they moved to Sebringville in 2014, where they've been going strong ever since.

The diner is renowned for its hearty breakfasts, featuring real potatoes used for home fries and French fries. Lunch and dinner options include favourites like fish and chips battered in-house, and the famous grilled cheese made with homemade bread. Dave's Diner also offers Water Buffalo burgers sourced from a local farm, reflecting their commitment to supporting local producers.

Housed in a century-old building next to the Esso station, the diner exudes character and charm. It is wheelchair accessible and provides amenities such as Wi-Fi. The diner is licensed to serve beer, enhancing the dining experience.
