Together with their wives, Inge and Irene, they expanded the farm with innovative practices, including a biogas plant and the introduction of water buffalo, embracing sustainable methods.

Over a decade ago, Henry and Fred made a bold move, bringing 150 water buffalo from Florida to diversify their dairy operation. This strategic decision created an Ontario market for buffalo mozzarella, previously imported at high costs from Italy, opening new opportunities for their children. Today, the Koskamp family's water buffalo operation thrives, with their products sold across Toronto, London, Woodstock, Kitchener and Windsor.

Driven by a shared ambition to honour their family legacy, siblings Andrew, Jacqueline, Theo, Philip, and Darien formed Kampkreek Dairies. United by a common goal, they dedicated themselves to continuing their parents' legacy, contributing uniquely to the local agricultural landscape.

The community's welcoming attitude toward new businesses and innovation has provided a fertile ground for their ventures.
