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Section 1: Fulcher Family Tree

- Names and identification number of each descendant of Thomas Fulcher [60] and Rose Bird [61]. Each new generation is indented. It should be noted that the tree is not complete as it only those members for which there is a photo or other documentation. This particular family tree focuses on the descendants of Joseph Fulcher [60-61f] and Sarah Crisp [60-61f.Sp.] up to the 6th generation. The Fulcher family emigrated from England to Upper Canada in the early half of the 19th century.

Note: This family tree may contain inaccuracies, especially in the Joseph Fulcher 60-61f family.

Note on Organization of the Family Tree:

1. Each person has been designated a number which correlates to their position on the family tree. The first two identified members of the family are each given a number. Each consecutive child is then given a letter to the end of that number. For example, the first child is 1-2a, the second child is 1-2b, and so on. The numbering system continues with each new generation being given an additional letter signifying their position within the tree.
2. Each spouse of a direct descendant is designated with Sp. for Spouse. For example, if they are married to the third child in the family tree, they would be numbered as, "1-2c.Sp." If they have more than more spouse, it will be denoted by a number after the Sp. "1-2c.Sp.2."

If an individual in this family tree is connected to another family associated with the project, that person's identification number will change in their second tree.

I have discovered that David's family letters are available through the Letters & Images Project located at Vancouver Island University's history department (www.canadianletters.ca). Here is his last letter. Because we know what is coming there is an increased poignancy to Dave's last letter to Lettie:

France April 5th
Dear Lettie

I received your letter dated March 10th tonight. Glad to hear that you were well. I wrote you a few days ago saying I had received the box which you sent away March 8th but I have not received the one you sent March 1st yet. Alex said he was sending a box so I will have it some of these days. I had a letter from Alf Gillam to night so must answer it to night. I was glad to hear that you have every(thing) paid up so you can put what you have over in the bank to see when I came back. We have been having some cold wet and snowy weather but today has been fine and sunny so it looks as if the weather has turned fine. We are out of the trenches at present so thought I would write you a few line before going back again. I did not know until today when Easter Sunday was for I did not think it was so near and this is Good Friday but I don't think I will have any eggs this Easter but hope to make up for it next one. I bought a quart of milk the other night. I drank half of it and I boiled the other half and bought three eggs which I paid six cents each for and boiled them in the milk so made a fine custard but it was rather dear for all the wealth I have but it was the second time I have tasted milk since coming to France. There is very seldom we are where we can buy milk. About the only things we can buy at times is biscuits and chocolate. I may not write a letter to you for some time but will try and send you a field card when I can. Hope you and George are always keeping well. You were asking me what to send in your boxes, well don't go to any expense getting boxes for me but don't send anything that isn't for eating. But I am getting along all right so don't worry about me. I have a few boils in the back of my neck just now to amuse me. I suppose I need some spring medicine. Well I will close this time. Hoping you are well. With lots of love from

Dave

Here is the final letter in the series:
July 6, 1917

Personal

Dear Mrs. McLean,

I desire to express to you my sincere sympathy in the recent decease of your husband, No. 799658 Pte. David McLean. Who in sacrificing his life at the front in action with the enemy, has rendered the highest services of a worthy citizen.

The heavy loss which you and the Nation have sustained would indeed be dressing were it not redeemed by the knowledge that the brave comrade for whom we mourn performed his duties fearlessly and well as become a good soldier, and gave his life for the great cause of Human Liberty and the defense of the Empire. Again extending to you in your bereavement my condolence and heartfelt sympathy.

Vimy Ridge - Thomas Grant (friend of David McLean)

GALLANT SCOTSMAN KILLED.

In the person of Pte. Thos. P. Grant another gallant Scotch-Canadian has made the supreme sacrifice.



He was killed in action August 15 at the age of 34. He went overseas just a year ago in the 134th Battalion. By trade he was a carpenter.

His widow and two children, May, aged eight, and Pringle, aged seven, live at 29 Eastmount' avenue.

In a recent blog I told the story of David McLean who was married to Bob Hearn's cousin Lettie Vanstone. David was killed at Vimy Ridge as he sheltered in a dugout with his friend Tom Grant. The two men, both native born Scots, lived on the same street in Toronto. They had enlisted together, trained together and remained in the same regiment in Europe. They had made a pact that if one was to die the other would write home breaking the news to the widow. In the shell attack that killed David McLean his friend Tom was not seriously injured. True to his word Tom wrote home to Lettie Mclean telling her of David's death. I wondered in the blog how Tom carried on after the death of his friend and whether he survived the war. I now have discovered that Tom Grant was killed on 15 August 2012 during an attack on Hill 70. I have attached a newspaper notice of his death. Sadly, there was no one to write home to his widow. Thomas Pringle Grant's name is inscribed on the Vimy Memorial.

Vimy Ridge Dave McLean Christmas letter 1916

In the last post I related the story of David McLean a Scots emigrant to Canada who married my Grandfather's first cousin, Lettie Vanstone. David died on Vimy Ridge on 20 April 1917. I subsequently have discovered a letter which he wrote to Lettie at Christmas 1916 only a few months before the fatal battle. Here is the letter:

" France

Dear Lettie:

I received your letter of December 5th two days ago and was pleased to hear you were keeping well. This is Christmas Day and we're back in billets for a time. The morning was wet but it is clear and cold now. We had our Christmas dinner in a big tent we put up for the occasion. Big enough to seat the whole company. So we sat down about 12 and our menu consisted of roast pork with mashed potatoes, carrots, cabbage, beans and applesauce and custard pudding with prunes, orange nuts, cigars, cigarettes, tobacco and I received a small parcel of handkerchiefs and chocolate and a parcel from the officers and men of the 134th which contained a pipe and chocolate and our officers waited on tables. And we were well looked after too and the pipe band was in the tent playing while we were eating and we had speeches and singing and altogether we had a splendid time which was far better than ever I expected under the circumstances. I was only wishing that you would be enjoying yourself at home as well as we were.

I received a box last night Christmas Eve from Winnipeg and I suppose it was from father ... It was the best box that I have got yet. There was a pair of socks, a fruitcake in a square tin box, a box of chocolates, a bottle of malted milk tablets, a box of cough tablets, zam buck, sardines, handkerchiefs, gum, peppermints, Oxo, insect powder. Alex sent a small stove so we have a hot drink often.

Battle of Vimy Ridge - David McLean

Lettie Vanstone was Bob Hearn's first cousin. Their mothers were sisters, the daughters of Joseph and Sarah Fulcher. Letta lived on Queen Street in St. Marys across from the present-day hospital. I have no pictures of Lettie but there are a few reports in the local newspaper of her attending a wedding in Forest or communicating with relatives in the United States. At some point she met and married David McLean who had emigrated, along with his parents and brother, from Scotland. Lettie and David lived in Toronto where David was a foreman at Dooderham and Worts distillery. They had one son George. In January 1916, when the first war was well into the heavy slogging phase, David and a friend, who lived on the same street, reported to the Toronto Recruiting Depot and joined the 48th Highlanders. In August 1916 "after a period of hard training at Camp Borden, [they] completed their final leave and strode down the street together en route for overseas. Each had agreed that should some mishap overtake one of them the other was to advise the family folk with all due speed. During Easter week, which will always be remembered in Canadian history because of the gallantry of the Dominion's representatives at Vimy Ridge, the two comrades, shoulder to shoulder, charged over the parapet and helped to capture the enemy's trenches. on April 20th when enjoying a rest in a dug-out a shrapnel shell burst near them. A fragment hit Pte. McLean on the temple and knocked him unconscious. Other pieces of shrapnel badly wounded him about the legs. Fifteen minutes later Pte. McLean passed on, and his friend, true to the promise made, wrote the sad news home." (The quotes above have been pieced together from articles in the Evening Telegram 18 May 1917, p. 21 and the St. Marys Journal 24 May 1917, p. 5).

David McLean died almost exactly 100 years ago today on 20 April 2017. His name is inscribed on the Vimy Memorial. I have no record of how David's wife Lettie or their 10 year-old son George spent the remainder of their lives. Nor do I have any record of whether David's comrade T. P. Grant from down the street on Eastmount Avenue survived the war. I have attached the official Record of Service card recording the death of David McLean.

On Saturday, September 8th, 1888, life's last door closed and left on its outer portal one of the pioneers of this district, in the person of Mrs. Joseph Fulcher. Mrs. Fulcher, nee Miss Eliza Waun, was born on the 10th of December, 1826 and was consequently 61 years and 0 mo. of age at the time of her death. In 1845 she was married to Joseph Fulcher, and they settled on the farm where she died, lot 44, concession 14, Downie, 43 years ago. The result of the union was a family of fourteen children—ten boys and four girls—all of whom survive her. For many years they lived—a happy family—on the homestead, until the eldges one called forth to fight their own battles for daily bread, but the grim messenger at last brought the fatal summons and Time, with his scythe, severed the first tie in the bond that united them and left a vacant chair. The family were all present when the last sad earthly rites were performed, on Monday last, and the tender mother, loving wife, and estimable neighbor was laid to rest in the bosom of mother Earth. The bereaved husband and children have the sincere sympathy of all to whom they are known.

Sudden Death.
We regret to have to announce, this week, the awfully sudden death of Mrs Joseph Fulcher, of Downie. She had been in her usual health up to Tuesday of last week when she began to complain, but nothing serious was apprehended till Saturday evening. When her husband came home from his work on the evening named she thought it would be well to send for a doctor and her request was at once complied with. In a short time afterwards she told her youngest daughter that she would lie down and take a rest and another daughter coming into the room almost immediately believed her mother to be dying and called her father who arrived just in time to see his faithful partner breathe her last. Mr. and Mrs Fulcher were among the pioneers of this district. When they settled on the Downie townline, trees grew where the St. Marys market is now situated. Deceased was kind-hearted to a fault and held in the highest esteem by all her acquaintances. She raised fourteen children, ten boys and four girls, all of whom are alive, who together with a grief-stricken husband mourn the loss of a loving mother and affectionate wife. At the time of her death she was in her sixty-second year.

Sarah Fulcher – William Harrison family

William Harrison was born in Middleton County, Ontario in October 1849. His father, Robert Harrison (1812-1869) immigrated to Canada from Armagh, Ireland and married Mary Clark (1808-1887) who was born in New Brunswick, Canada.

William was the second of three sons: James (1845-1934), William (1849-1932) and Robert (1850- 1925). The family had a farm south of the 2nd concession in Middleton, Norfolk County, Ontario. They eventually moved to the 4th Concession, Lot 27- in Amaranth, Dufferin, Ontario.

William married Sarah Elizabeth Fulcher (1851-1907) on October 21, 1874 in London, Ontario. The couple had nine (9) children:

Margaret E. Harrison was born July 30, 1875 in Amaranth Dufferin, ON. (as stated on her birth certificate). Her married name is Cassidy and according to her brother Clarence's obit, she was living Buffalo, NY in 1949. The couple had two children- William and Edward Cassidy.

Joel Robert Harrison was born in Wallace, Perth, ON. Joel immigrated to the US in 1893 and settled in Buffalo, NY. His wife's name was Ora Fancher and they had two daughters (Edna and Orabelle m. Vogel). Ora died in 1919. His second wife was named Katherine Barrow. Joel died in 1945 in Buffalo, NY.

Mary P. Harrison (b. 1879 in Ontario). She married Frank Judd who was born in England but immigrated to Canada as a child. The couple had five children: Evert Roy, Edith Pearl, Harold Lester, Eva Lillian and Gilbert Ray. The first three children were born in St. Mary's, Ontario and the last two were born in Hamilton, Ont.

William Harrison b. July 12, 1882.

Married Clara Corney in Hamilton, Ontario and resided most of his life in Buffalo, NY. The couple had two children, Laurence and Clarabelle. William died in 1963 in Buffalo, NY.

Isabella Louise Harrison b. 30 November 1885. Married John Gerald Snoddy in St. Mary's Perth. The couple had four children all born in St. Mary's: John Harrison, Frederick Norman, William Gerald and Isabel. Isabella Louise died in 1978 in St. Mary's.

James Ernest was born 1887 and died in May 1908 at the age of 20-21 years old. His death certificate indicates that he was tragically killed by a rock explosion while working in North Bend, Washington. His body was returned to St. Mary's for burial.

Frank Chester Harrison was born 24 May, 1890 in St. Mary's, ON. He immigrated to the US to Buffalo, NY in 1917. Frank died on 4 January 1960 in Buffalo, NY.

Clarence Howard Harrison was born on 12 February 1895 in St. Mary's Ontario. He was a veteran of World War 1 and was a railroad freight conductor. His wife's name was Loretta Beck from Cincinnati, OH. Clarence died at the age of 53 in Willard, Ohio.

Based upon sources, Reeve P. Harrison (1869-1956) appears to be the child of Sarah Fulcher born in 1869 when Sarah was 19 years old. He appears in the 1871 census with the Fulcher family listed as Phillip Reeve Fulcher. He then appears in the 1881 census with the Harrison family listed as Phillip Harrison. William Harrison was still living in Amaranth with his mother and brothers at the time of Reeve's birth. It is assumed that William adopted Reeve as his son when he married Sarah in 1874.

A series of arrival manifests between 1917 and 1923 indicate that he was entering the US to live with his son William. William's death certificate indicates that he died on December 16, 1932 in Buffalo, NY. His body was returned to St. Mary's for burial.

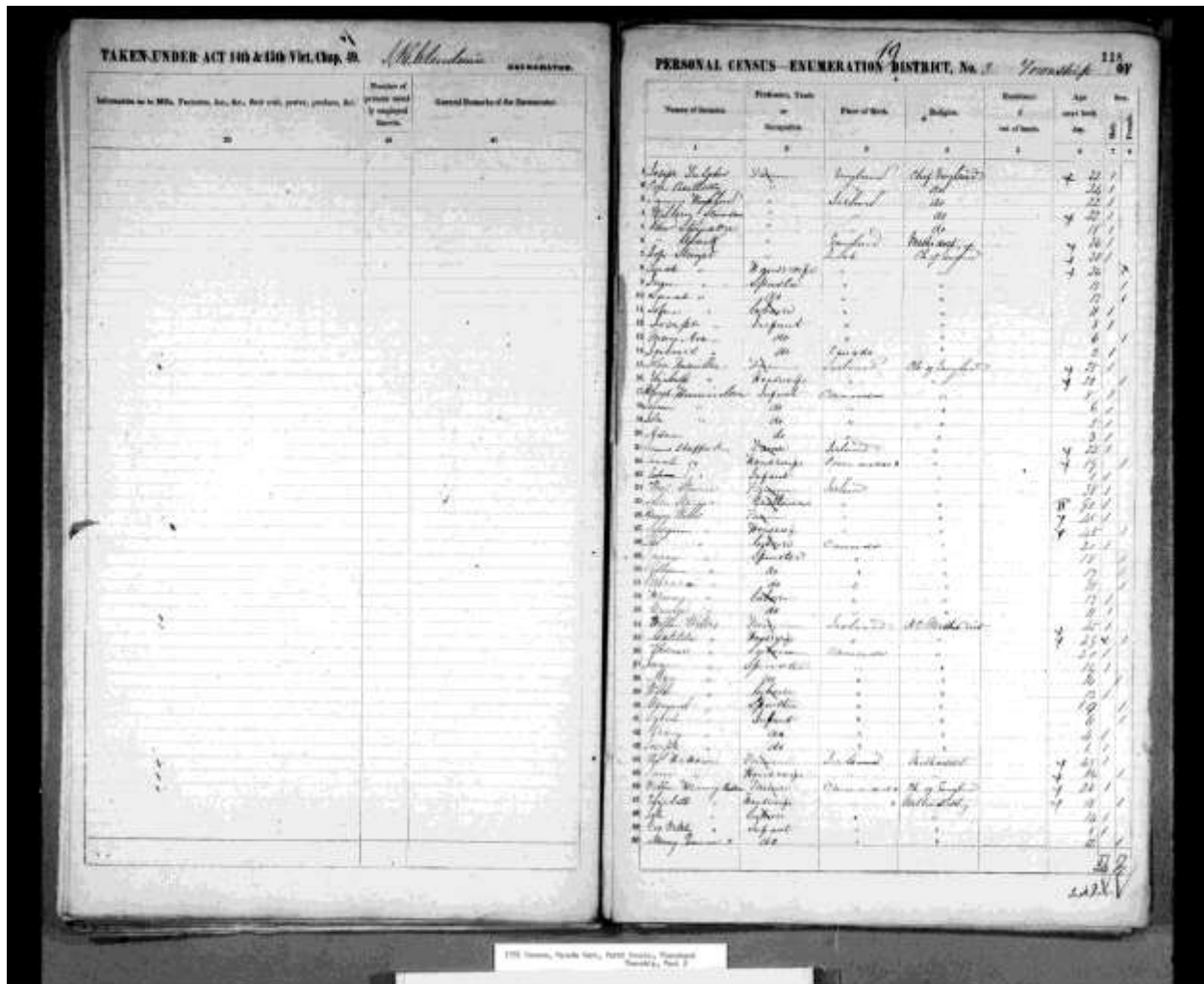
