Crafted with the same care and character as everything else on the farm, Applebottom's debut blends, Twenty-Two and Bottoms Up, are made with homegrown apples and a whole lot of heart. Twenty-Two is smooth and slightly sweet, while Bottoms Up delivers a crisp, cheeky kick to get the party started. Cider is available through direct message or at the farm during open hours.

The orchard's deep commitment to community continues through seasonal experiences and local initiatives. Whether you're harvesting fruit, sipping cider, or learning something new about local farming, Applebottom invites you to slow down, dig in, and savor what's grown close to home.
