Section 1: Moore Family Tree

- Names and identification number of each descendant of Robert Moore [36] and Catherine *McKendrick* Moore [37]. Each new generation is indented. It should be noted that the tree is not complete. It contains only those members for which there is a photo or other documentation.

Note on Organization of the Family Tree:

1. Each person has been designated a number which correlates to their position on the family tree. The first two identified members of the family are each given a number. Each consecutive child is then given a letter to the end of that number. For example, the first child is 1-2a, the second child is 1-2b, and so on. The numbering system continues with each new generation being given an additional letter signifying their position within the tree.
2. Each spouse of a direct descendant is designated with Sp. for Spouse. For example, if they are married to the third child in the family tree, they would be numbered as, "1-2c.Sp." If they have more than more spouse, it will be denoted by a number after the Sp. "1-2c.Sp.2."

If an individual in this family tree is connected to another family associated with the project, that person's identification number will change in their second tree.

With One 80 Years Ago

JUNE 12, 1939.

ST. MARYS, June 12—making a lot of money isn't what counts in this world, said Tom Moore, who has lived just about all his life in and around St. Marys and who is now in his 89th year. He added to the statement that it is how you lived and whether or not you've enjoyed life that counts most.

Tom Moore said he had enjoyed life and you couldn't help but know he was telling the truth after a glance at a happy twinkle in his eyes and a permanent smile beneath a handsome set of snow-white whiskers. He chuckled when he asked the photographer if he would mind waiting while he went into the house and had a shave.

Last week Tom Moore walked a few steps to the railroad tracks and saw the giant of the steel rails and the silver and blue train bearing Their Majesties roll through St. Marys. His memory turned back more than eighty years to the day he saw the first train of his life.

Recalls Incident:

"They had just laid the track near Kelly's siding and it was mostly on a mud roadbed and the train nosed into the ditch. It was quite a sight and everyone wondered how under the sun they were going to get it back. The folks gathered from miles around to see the funny-looking thing down in the ditch. It had a chimney on it nearly as high as a house and it certainly was different to that in which is taking the King and Queen around the country," said Moore.

At those same funny-looking times meant dollars and cents to Tom Moore in later life when he loved farming, because there was great demand for cord wood, cut four-foot lengths to be used to start steam. He recalled one winter when 3,200 cords of wood were hauled by sleigh to St. Marys Junction.

The average pay for cord wood those days was about \$2.25 per cord and it was considered a fair price at that.

Tom Moore was always an admirer and is still a great admirer of good horses. He was always proud of the fact he owned just about as good spans of horses as there were in the whole district of East Nisour. His best team, he said, was used for hauling cord wood all the way to the Junction for the trains

Fine Old Pioneer



TOM MOORE, well-known St. Marys resident, now in his 89th year, who recalls the days when East Nisour was all bush-land.

David Harum in his younger days and delights in telling of the humorous side of some of his trades in horses. He also likes to say that he was good as a plowman and said it always made him feel good to have farmers passing by, drop in and admire his work in the fields.

In fairly good health now, Mr. Moore works around the garden.

Cleared Land

"The trouble with most people is they start thinking they're sick and the first thing you know they are sick," he chuckled. His father was the late Robert Moore, an early settler in East Nisour. Mr. Moore recalls the days of clearing land, the family having taken fifty acres to start with and only a small portion of that area had been cleared then.

Mrs. Moore is also in good health and the happy couple have been married 59 years. After their marriage they farmed just north of St. Marys for a good number of years and it was about thirty-two years ago they moved here. For some years Mr. Moore bought and sold

Mr. Moore was lived at his place in East Nissouri, Downie township and for the past thirty years he and his wife have resided here. Until his removal to St. Marys he was farming but had many sidelines, the greatest of which was pressing hay, which occupation he carried on after coming to this town. He was also a cattle drover and in other lines of business he earned a circle of friends that is enviable. He is known for miles around as "Tom Moore, the hay presser."

Suffered Injury.

He was forced to cease his business about six years ago, when in jumping from a box car while loading hay at the C.N.R. yards here, he suffered a very bad fracture of the leg. At that time he had hopes of returning to his trade but has not started as yet and does not figure on doing so now. Except for that bad leg, though, he is as well and appears as able to carry on his work as well as ever.

This couple, who are close to fifty-six years of married life, had no advice to offer concerning matrimony but the harmony and the comforts of their well kept home speaks for itself. Both are jovial and happy as they remember the hardships endured in the early days and remarked it was almost unbelievable the changes that have taken place in their lifetime. One instance cited by Mrs. Moore, was when she was about eight years of age, she and two brothers walked barefoot from their home in Downie township, to the C.N.R. overhead bridge, here, across Trout creek in order to witness the first train to pass over it after it had been completed. Mrs. Moore added that they did not go right into the town that day but only as far as the bridge.

His First Skates.

Mr. Moore also could remember when, as a boy, he asked his father to buy him a pair of skates. Money was scarce and so the father told him to cut a load of wood and take it to town. He did this and purchased his skates, for the huge price of twenty-five cents. There was still a dollar and a quarter left out of the wood money. That was the way things sold in those days. At that time, the Moore family was living on the 9th concession of East Nissouri where William Bradley now lives.

Both can remember quite distinctly the reign of Queen Victoria, and related that in those days, it was a holiday on her birthday if never again during the whole year. Mr. Moore was quite an athlete during his younger days and he proudly told of his participating in sport events on the 24th of May.

Mr. and Mrs. Moore were married in the Baptist Church manse in the west ward, here, and the honeymoon consisted of two days in London. This lady and gentlemen, are without doubt, one of the most congenial couples and their years, to appearances, are very deceiving. They both look a great deal younger and this is largely due to the fact that Mrs. Moore has never had an illness that necessitated calling a doctor while Mr. Moore, while still on the farm, was ill with typhoid fever but not again until his accident that forced him out of the business to which he was so attached.

THOMAS MOORE

Another highly-esteemed old-timer, Thomas Moore, Treacy Street, passed to his rest in his 91st year on Thursday, August 5th, having been a resident of the Stone Town since his early manhood.

The late Mr. Moore, was born at Bronte, Ontario, the son of the late Mr. and Mrs. Robert Moore. His father, who was a sailor on the Great Lakes, later moved with his family to the bush wilderness of Nissouri and Tom, who was then four years of age, had lived first on concession 2 of West Nissouri, and then on concession 9 of East Nissouri.

Sixty-three years ago he married Mary Anne Mennie, who was a daughter of Downie pioneers, and on the death of her father, her husband worked the farm for six years. He then started farming on his own two miles north of St. Marys, and 36 years ago moved into town which had been his home ever since. His wife died in 1940, very shortly after they celebrated their diamond jubilee.

By trade he was a hay-presser for 45 years, and also shipped cattle and hogs for the late W. H. Graham. He was a genial man of powerful physique and was a member of Knox Presbyterian Church and of the Sons of Scotland.

Four years ago Mr. Moore fractured his hip and had been confined to bed ever since, his daughter, Mrs. Minnie Hern, having devotedly attended to his needs during the entire period.

Surviving him are his sons, William of Winnipeg, Garret of Detroit, and Fred of Aberdeen; his daughters, Mrs. Minnie Hern of St. Marys; Jessie, Mrs. William Walz of Stratford; and Kate, Mrs. Charles Smith of Hamilton; his sisters, Mrs. Kate Baisdon of Vancouver, and Mrs. Lizzie Morgeson of Key City, Michigan; and his brother John of California. There are also 17 grandchildren, of whom one is Miss Dorothea Walz, St. Marys, public health nurse, and three great-grandchildren.

The funeral service was held at the L. A. Ball Funeral Chapel on Saturday last, Rev. W. E. Aldworth officiating. Interment followed in St. Marys Cemetery.
